Being a Committee and/or Task Force member allows for important participation with the Agency without the fiduciary responsibility of being a member of the Board of Directors.

Each Member also participates and contributes towards achievement of the agency's strategic goals in one or more of the following ways:

- ✓ Understand BBBSNH's mission and programs
- ✓ Commit to serve one full 2-year term
- ✓ Actively work with staff or Board on at least one specific agency priority
- ✓ Make an annual contribution to the agency with a give or get from other resources \$1,000 (may also include in-kind donations)
- ✓ Support, participate in or volunteer at the agency's major fund raising events each year (the one you have joined) and participate in the Thankful Giving Campaign by setting up a fundraising page.
- ✓ Expectation is to attend 100% of Committee and/or Task Meeting(s) whether in-person, phone or communication platform (e.g. Slack).
- ✓ Provide additional, significant contributions to the agency through:
 - Stewarding the agency's current financial and community supporters
 - Reach into personal networks to cultivate and solicit new individuals into the "extended Big Brothers Big Sisters family" of financial and in-kind donors, community advocates, programmatic collaborators, mentor-rich sponsors and partners, celebrities, business and civic leaders and foundations
 - Providing leadership and counsel to staff and other Board Members for specifically identified, strategic initiatives
- ✓ Be vigilant for:

 - Big Brother Big Sister volunteer recruiting sources
 - Prospective Committee and/or Task Force members
 - Media and public relations opportunities
 - Political, community and corporate visibility and networking opportunities
